

## THE WOMEN'S FUND OF GREATER BIRMINGHAM

**The event:** The "Women Moving Forward" reception at Park Lane on March 30 honored three history-making women to celebrate Women's History Month. One honored — **Jane Comer** — is from Birmingham.

**The scene:** Keynote speaker **Helen LaKelly Hunt**, heir to the Texas Hunt oil fortune, founded the Dallas Women's Foundation, the New York Women's Foundation and Women's Funding Network. She shared the story of her decision to put her inheritance to work in support of other women, adding that, for the first time in history, women are funding a movement to empower women around the globe.

Women's Funding Network executive director **Chris Grumm** talked about the success of the Women Moving Millions campaign that raised more than \$115 million for women's funds around the world.

The event also honored Jane, who is the first woman in the South, west of Atlanta,

to contribute \$1 million to the Women Moving Millions campaign. Her gift is designated for The Women's Fund of Greater Birmingham; The Women's Funding Network; Ms. Foundation for planned parenthood living wage grants; and the CHIPS clinic at Children's Hospital to implement a childhood sexual abuse prevention program in Alabama.

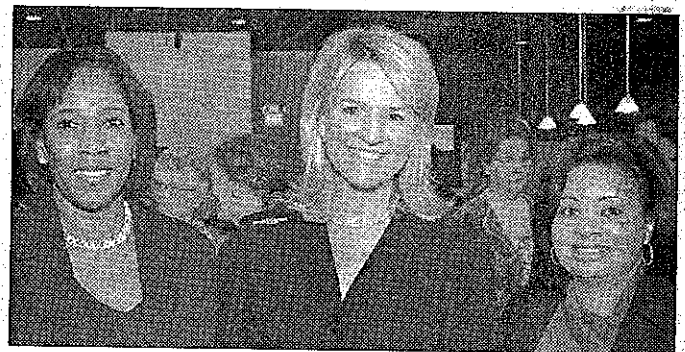
